#### **LIVE AUDITIONS**

#### **DATES**

Mon 23 September, Mon 21 October and Mon 18 November 2024.

#### TIME

Auditions will commence 9.00am sharp on each day, the studios will be open from 8.30am for you to warm up. Finishing time is approximately 2.00pm, please allow some flexibility.

#### **VENUE**

Adelaide College of the Arts, 39 Light Square, Adelaide, 3rd Floor, Dance Rehearsal Studio.

#### **AUDITION REQUIREMENTS**

As part of the audition process, you will be asked to demonstrate your skills in the following dance techniques:

- > Classical ballet including barre work, centre work and pirouettes.
- > Contemporary dance technique. Due to the variety of training styles no specific technique is required.

#### **VIDEO AUDITIONS**

The video audition submission must contain 3 sections:

#### **SECTION 1**

20 minutes of a classical ballet class including: barre work, centre work and pirouettes.

#### **SECTION 2**

20 minutes of contemporary dance technique. Due to the variety of training styles no specific technique is required.

#### **SECTION 3**

3 minutes of a creative solo (contemporary style). This is your opportunity to be expressive/creative.

Maximum allowed 45 minutes.

Video submission open 22 July and close 29 November 2024 and are accepted via email to admissions@tafesa.edu.au

#### **NEXT STEPS**

To attend an audition, you are required to apply for one of the following dance courses:

- > Certificate IV in Dance (CUA40120)
- > Bachelor of Creative Arts (Dance)

Once you have applied for the course you will then receive an email from our Admissions team with details about the audition.
